He taught English and Drama and was involved in the production of many theater productions with the students at these schools, receiving recognition in 2005 from Mater Christi Drama Club. He was also involved with theater groups in the NY metropolitan area. A funeral mass was offered at St. Thomas Aquinas Church in Brooklyn on March 19th with burial at Greenwood Cemetery.
